Language Objectives

- > to **understand** the verbs attached to safety equipment
- > to **follow** and **give** instructions
- > to **use** prepositions of placement

Materials:

- > Eye protection and Ear protection items/SLIDE
- Prepositions relating to Place Worksheet/ SLIDE for each learner
- Missing Preposition Cards for each pair

Using Safety Equipment

Instructions:

1. Lead the learners through the following and similar commands two or three times:

Instructor Note

The first time through the commands, do the action with the learners but NOT on the second and third.

- everyone put their safety equipment (imaginary if none is available) in front of them
- pick up your safety glasses
- put on your safety glasses
- take your ear plugs
- put them in your ears
- take out your ear plugs
- put them on the table
- take off your glasses
- put the glasses down
- put them beside the ear plugs
- · use your safety glasses
- use your ear plugs
- return the safety equipment to the table
- put the ear plugs to the right of the glasses
- · exchange glasses with your neighbour
- return them to the owner
- put your glasses at the edge of the table
- return all the equipment to the proper place
- 2. Ask some of the advanced learners to take turns giving commands.

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Eye/Ear Protection Items SLIDE

- 3. Remind the learners of the difference in meaning and use of the prepositions 'on', 'in' and 'at', using the **Prepositions relating to Place Worksheet/SLIDE.**
 - on is used when the place (noun) following it is a surface, like a line e.g. table, floor, street
 - *in* is appropriate when the place (noun) following it is a **container** or enclosed area, e.g. box, department, ear
 - at is used when the place (noun) following it is a **point** e.g. the corner, the edge

Instructor Note

Give each learner a copy of the **Prepositions SLIDE** as a resource.

- 4. Hand out a set of **Missing Preposition Cards** to each pair of learners.
 - Place the cards blank side up and answer side down in a pile between them.
 - Instruct the learners to take turns picking a card from the pile with the answer side facing their partner and the blank side facing themselves.
 - The learner with the blank side reads the sentence inserting the appropriate preposition.
 - The partner will check if the correct choice was made.

Instructor Note

The missing preposition cards: Print the pages back to back so that the blank is on one side and answer on the other.

in x means inside or within the borders of an <u>area</u>

You live in Canada.

at X• means at a particular point
