Tools That We Use

Instructor Note

*Introduce the module to the learners by projecting the **Title Page SLIDE** and explain the progression of tasks you will be doing together in order to achieve the goal of talking about **tools**.*

Instructions:

1. Put the class into groups.
2. Ask them to list (in pictures or words) as many tools that they can think of they use in their job.
3. Have each group tell the rest of the class what is on their list.
4. Hand out the **Tool Board Worksheet** to each learner.
 - Have the class name as many of the tools that they can that are on the **Tool Board Worksheet**.
 - Write the words onto the board as they name them.
 - Be sure to ask the learners to spell the names as you write them so that they can practice saying the names of the letters.
 - Just fill in as many as the class can name.
 - Return to this task at the end of the Module.
