Welcome to *How to Develop Academic Reading Skills,* a professional development course for teachers of English to speakers of other languages.

The purpose of this course is:

- 1) to provide instruction and practice on how to develop a variety of critical reading strategies that is useful for academic studies.
- 2) to provide opportunities for developing academic vocabulary through various learning strategies.
- 3) to read sections of the Acts of the Apostles academically

The course has twelve sessions. We have used a combination of tasks in each session: readings, interactions with units from *Developing Academic Reading Strategies\**, learning reflections, and group discussions.
