**Publicity:** Advertise the course through websites, Facebook, flyers, etc.

### **Registration:**

- Set up a method of registering that will give you the names of each student, email address, their English level, plus any other information that you need.
- Acknowledge each registration
- Assign learners into Breakout Room groups
- Send out the Zoom link and weekly workbook to each learner before each class
- Keep track of attendance

### **Lead Facilitator:**

- Send out Facilitator Instructions, Workbook and PowerPoint Slides to all the facilitators.
- Assign facilitators to work with the various learner levels of English
- Train facilitators in how to use the curriculum with Zoom
- Send out the weekly videos of the text after each lesson to the students who were in attendance.
- **Optional:** Create a certificate for the course that shows how many hours each student attended. These could be sent out by each facilitator.

### **Zoom Manager:**

- Function as host
- Enter the facilitators and the learners into the course
- Place the learners into the appropriate Breakout Room groups. (If the facilitators are made co-hosts, they can also do this.)
- Switch from large group to Breakout Room groups during the lesson at the appropriate times

## **Navigating System**

### **Navigating the PDF Document:**

- Ensure that the latest version of Acrobat Reader is on your computer. Go to: <https://get.adobe.com/reader/> and click on **Install**.
- Open the file titled **The Easter Story**. This opens to the **Cover Page** along with a left panel of bookmarks.
- Place your cursor  on the **Bookmark panel** (on the left side of the screen) and *click* **Session 1: The Last Supper**, to go to the **Session 1: The Last Supper** title page.
- Place the cursor on the **Facilitator Instructions** and *click* to go to the beginning page of the instructions.
- Once on the **Session Title Page**, *click* on the **Facilitator Instructions** to go to the beginning page of the instructions.
- This navigation system continues throughout the entire curriculum.
- Whenever your cursor changes to a 'pointing finger' there is a link to another page in the file. The whole curriculum is linked for quick reference from one session to another and to the differing pages in the curriculum.
